

Writing & discussion questions to accompany "I Have a Right to Vote!" video

- 1. The struggle to deliver voting rights for all Americans has been a long one. Can you identify at least two of the different historical periods and movements that are represented by the people whose quotations are featured in this video?
- 2. What visual "artifacts" of the civil rights movement appear in the video? Explain the importance of at least one of them.
 - a. What clips or parts of the video capture current issues with protecting voting rights today?
 - b. Why do you think many people are still concerned about making sure voting rights are protected for all Americans?
- 3. Choose one of the biographies of the people featured in the "I Have a Right to Vote!" voting rights anthem -- preferably one of a person you <u>hadn't</u> heard of before. Do some additional research on your own, and find out at least two other things that person did to fight for civil rights.
- 4. What is one question you would ask the composer who wrote and directed this song and video if you could?
