

**2025 Parent/Legal Guardian Agreement Form**

Expanding Horizons Institute (EHI) has provided first-generation, college-bound high school students with an intensive experience of skill development and personal growth that prepares them for college, career, and civic life through interactive seminars and paid summer internship.

To consider your child's EHI application, student must meet all the required criteria:

- ✓ Neither parent graduated from a 4-year college in or outside the U.S.
- ✓ Must attend a Title 1 high school (more than 40% of students receive free or reduced lunch).
- ✓ Must be a sophomore or junior.
- ✓ Must be available to attend all seminars and complete the internship hours\*

\*Your child must attend all 16 seminars and complete the internship hours (mid-April to mid-July), see website for dates, times, and location/format. If your child is absent from more than one seminar, your child will be considered being dropped from the program. Schedule any doctor's/ dentist's appointments on non-seminar/working days if possible and always provide a notice if student must miss a seminar.

- ✓ Must be eligible to work in the U.S.

The EHI application requires the student to submit the following by January 31, 2025:

- Part I Application Form
- Part II Application Form, which includes essay, 2 letters of recommendation, and unofficial transcript.
- Parent/Legal Guardian Agreement (this form)

If selected to participate, we will submit all required student work documentation (ID, social security, etc.).
