STEP ONE: Log on to <http://tabroom.com>

Have a Tabroom Account?

- Click on “Login”
- Log on to your account



Returning Volunteers:

As a returning user, (if you are using the same device as when you have volunteered in the past) your login information should automatically be saved on your device.

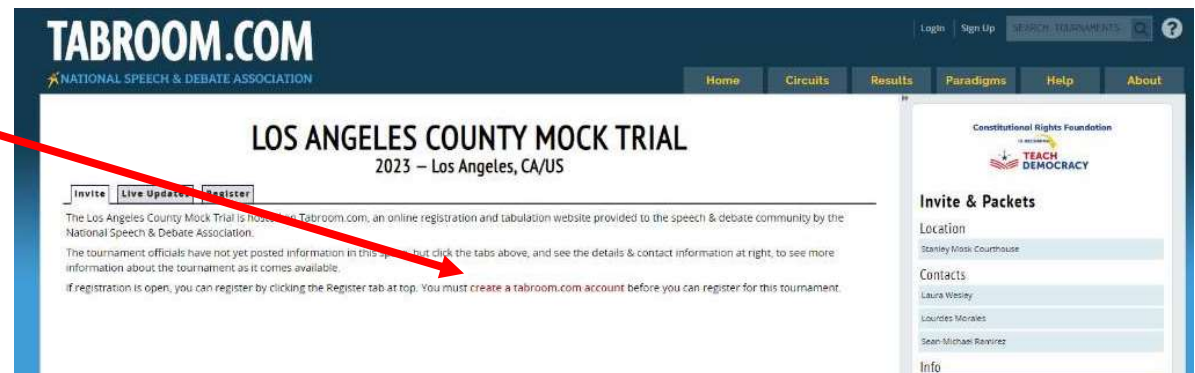
If you have forgotten your login information, click on login at the top of the page and then click on ‘forgot your password’ and follow the instructions.

Create a Tabroom account

- Click on “Create a Tabroom Account” in the middle of the page.
- Fill out the information underneath the “Non-NSDA Members” heading. A phone number is required in case we need to reach you during the competition.
- You will receive an email from Tabroom.com with a verification code to the email provided to complete your Tabroom account.

Fill out all the necessary information on the Judges, Attorneys, and Law Students Signup form.
