

## **Mock Trial State Finals**

## 2025 Observer Form

Each team (both prosecution <u>and</u> defense) is required to designate an <u>adult</u> to serve as the official Courtroom Observer. No one should enter the courtroom until the observers have entered and completed a survey of the room. The general rule is that nothing in the courtroom should be touched or moved by Mock Trial participants.

The observer's responsibilities include:

- Before teams enter the courtroom, make note of where chairs, easels, or other items are arranged. You can take photos of the courtroom, or you can create a diagram on the back of this form, so you know how things were originally placed.
- After each trial, ensure that all furniture and courtroom items are replaced to their original positions and conditions.
- Watching for proper treatment of the courtroom by participants and spectators during the trial.

The observer's responsibilities DO NOT include observing for rule or procedural violations.
