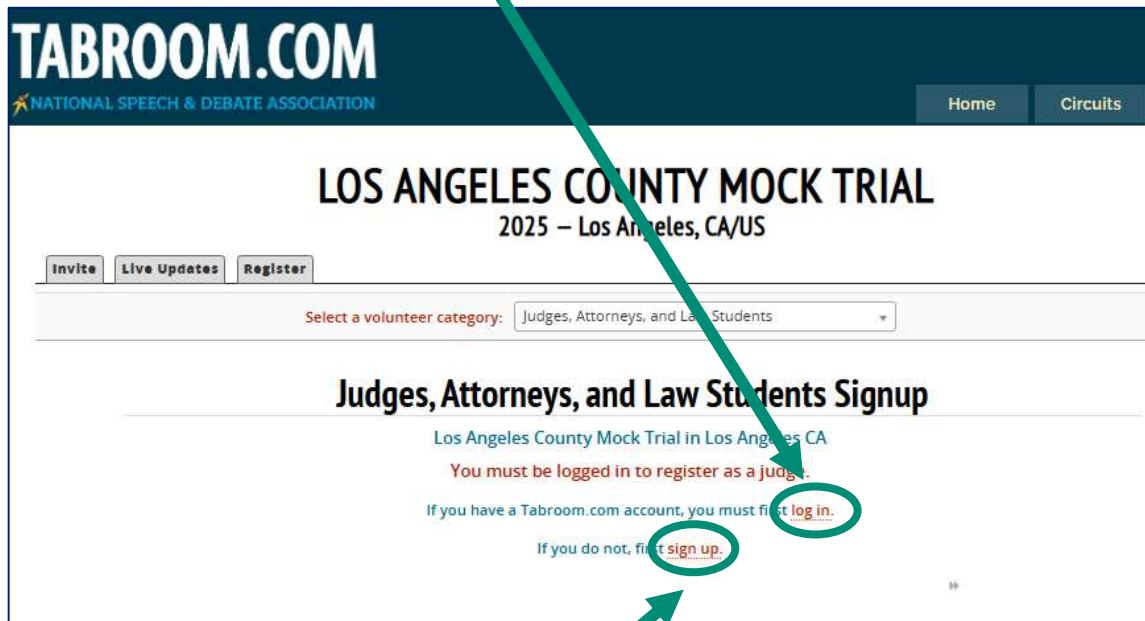


Tabroom Step-by-Step Guide

STEP ONE: Go to the [Volunteer Registration Page](#) and log in.

Returning Tabroom User (with a Tabroom account):

- In the middle of the page, click on “**log in**” and log in
- Go to Step Two



New to Tabroom (without a Tabroom account):

- In the middle of the page, click on “**sign up**”

Next Screen

- Fill out the information underneath the “**Otherwise, create a new account**” heading.
 - A phone number is required
 - Then click on “**Create account**”
 - You will receive an email from Tabroom.com with a verification code to the email provided to complete your Tabroom account.
- Once you have successfully logged in, go to Step Two.

STEP TWO: Complete all the necessary information on the [Volunteer Registration Page](#).

- **Instructions/Disclaimer:**

Check off “Yes” to confirm that you have read the above message and agree to its conditions.

- **Volunteer Category:**

Select your role - Attorney, Judge, Law Student.

- **Diversity Identification (OPTIONAL):**

Check off “Yes” if it applies.

- **Rounds:**

Select the rounds you are signing up for.

- **Please answer the questions below:**

Respond to two general questions.

- **Current Legal/Professional Affiliation:**

Enter your firm, law school, court, etc.

List any schools you have a conflict with.
