As a 2025 Mock Trial State Finals participant, I have read and agree to abide by **Rule 1.2 – Code of Ethical Conduct**. In addition, I agree to adhere to the following Courtroom Use Agreement.

Courthouse Use Agreement. I will:

- Follow the directions of Security Personnel, courthouse employees, and competition staff.
- Not roam the building or go on floors or in areas not being used for the competition.
- Display proper courtroom behavior and courtesy throughout the competition.
- Not enter the courtroom until both Courtroom Observers have completed their form.
- Not bring food, gum, or drink (except water) into the courtroom at any time.
- Not take, tamper with, or move courtroom equipment, materials, tables, chairs, personal items, etc.
- Not enter the judges' chambers or clerks' offices.
- Place trash in trash bins and recyclables in recyclable bins.
- Make sure the courtroom is left exactly as I found it.

I pledge to act with good sportsmanship and respect for others in both victory and defeat. I acknowledge that my actions will reflect upon my whole team, and any improper behavior may be grounds for point deductions, disqualification from a round, or expulsion from the competition.
