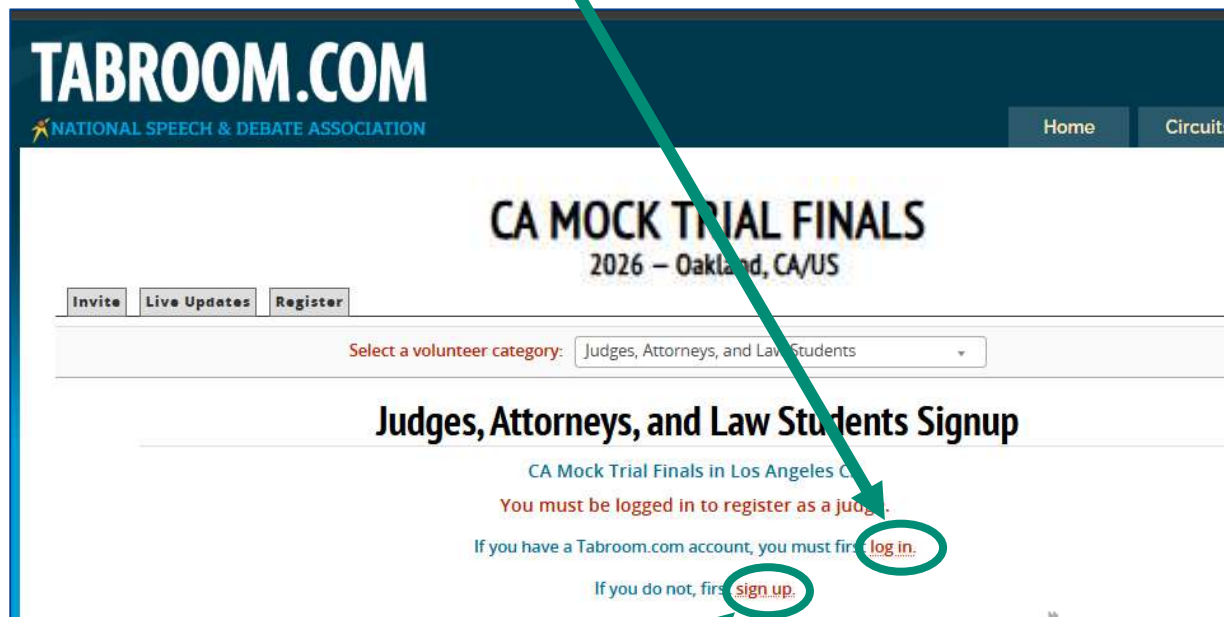


Tabroom Step-by-Step Guide

STEP ONE: Go to the [Volunteer Registration Page](#) and log in.

Returning Tabroom User (with a Tabroom account):

- In the middle of the page, click on **“log in”** and log in
- Go to Step Two



New to Tabroom (without a Tabroom account):

- In the middle of the page, click on **“sign up”**

Next Screen

- Fill out the information underneath the **“Otherwise, create a new account”** heading.
 - A phone number is required
 - Then click on **“Create account”**
 - You will receive an email from Tabroom.com with a verification code to the email provided to complete your Tabroom account.
- Once you have successfully logged in, go to Step Two.

STEP TWO: Complete all the necessary information on the [Volunteer Registration Page](#).

- **Instructions/Disclaimer:**

Check off “Yes” to confirm that you have read the above message and agree to its conditions.

- **Volunteer Category:**

Select your role:

- Attorney
- Judge
- Attorney – can preside if needed
- Law Student
